

## Halfmoon GOP names candidates



HALFMOON—John Hickok, Vice Chairman of the Town of Halfmoon Republican Committee, Wednesday announced the Committee's unanimously endorsed slate of candidates for the 2007 fall elections, expressing complete confidence in their collective "knowledge, skills, abilities and commitment to make Halfmoon a better place."
